_____ 5. Malintzin helped Hernán Cortés conquer the Aztec by arranging a meeting between Cortés and Moctezuma II.

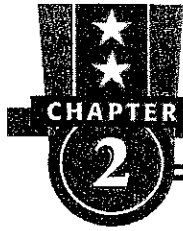
