Remember to site everything you use for your project. The rubric for this activity is on my website. Your presentations will need to be 3 – 5 minutes long.

## **Topics/terms:**

**Prohibition:** Origins, speakeasies, and sources of alcohol

**Traditionalism:** Nativism, KKK, religious fundamentalism, immigration restrictions

**Jazz:** Origins, singers, bandleaders, and race relations

**Movies:** Origins, talkies, film stars, and Birth of a Nation

**Harlem Renaissance:** Harlem, Langston Hughes, writers, themes

**Organized Crime:** Origins, Al Capone, St. Valentines Day Massacre, role in everyday life, types of crimes committed
